<b>Name of Role:</b>  <b>PARADE STEWARDS</b>	<b>Role Specifications:</b> <b>Assisting with safety and control for the three Parades taking place during the Festival from their departure point to route run and finish location</b>
<b>What?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each Steward will be assigned a Rose Float, Band, Group of Performers to assist with their participation in the Parades</li> <li>• To walk alongside their assigned parade unit being vigilant of both crowd control and performers and spectators safety</li> </ul>
<b>When?</b>	Periods: Sat. 21 <sup>st</sup> (8pm – 10pm), Sun. 22 <sup>nd</sup> (1.30pm – 3.30pm) & Tue 24 <sup>th</sup> (11pm – 12.30am) <i>(Times may vary slightly due to set-up requirements and also lateness)</i>
<b>Where?</b>	Sat. 21 <sup>st</sup> – Assemble @ Rose Dome site (Fels Point) / End – Denny St. Sun. 22 <sup>nd</sup> – Assemble @ Kingdom Greyhound Stadium / End – Denny St. Tue. 24 <sup>th</sup> – Assemble @ Ashe St, Courthouse / End – Denny St.
